

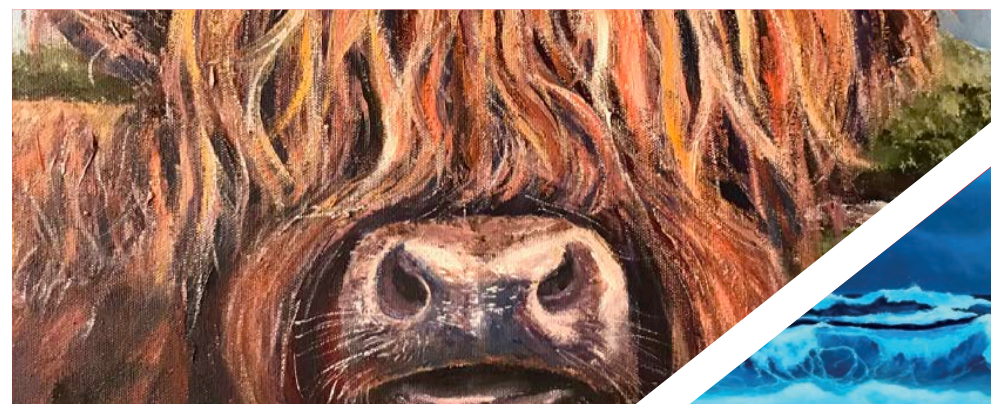

Early morning of a bright summer's day and the butterflies and bees are already up and about! A really heavenly, tranquil scene that's been created here to bring peace, joy and brightness to the viewer.

Varnished in a glossy varnish with UV protection to preserve my colours and supplied with a certificate of authenticity for future provenance. This piece is framed in a broad, luxurious high quality wooden frame that is strung at the back, ready for hanging.

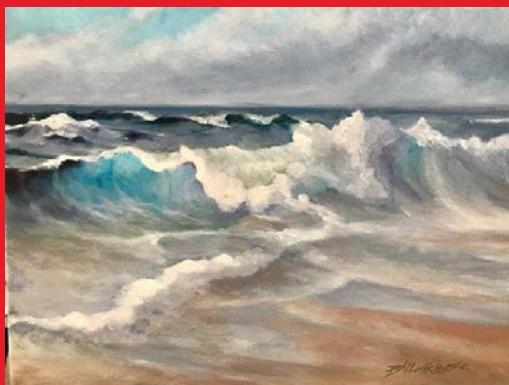

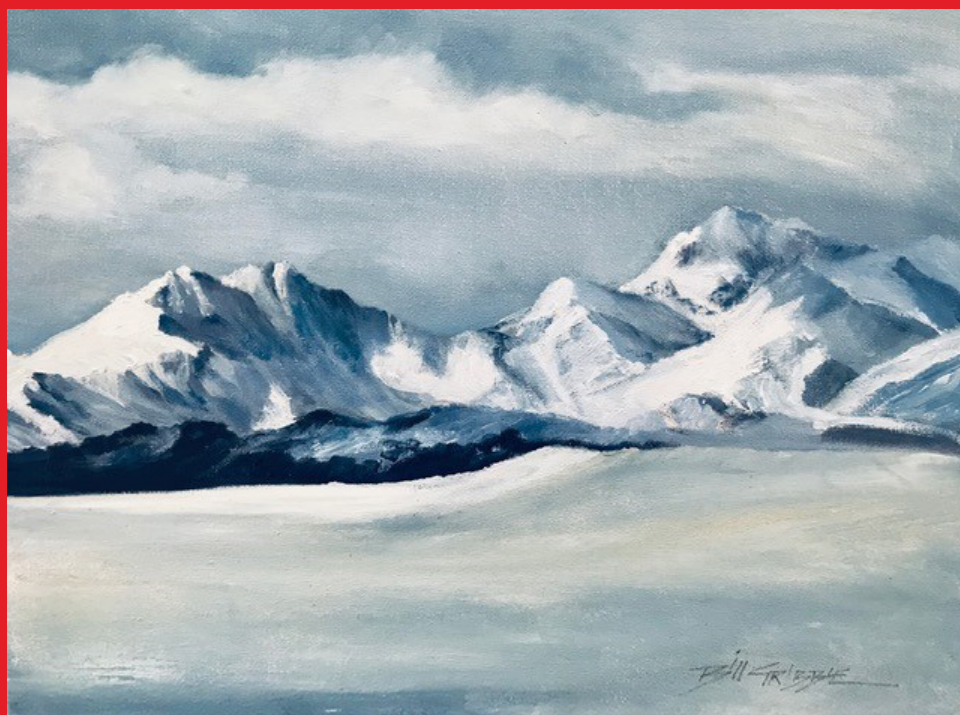

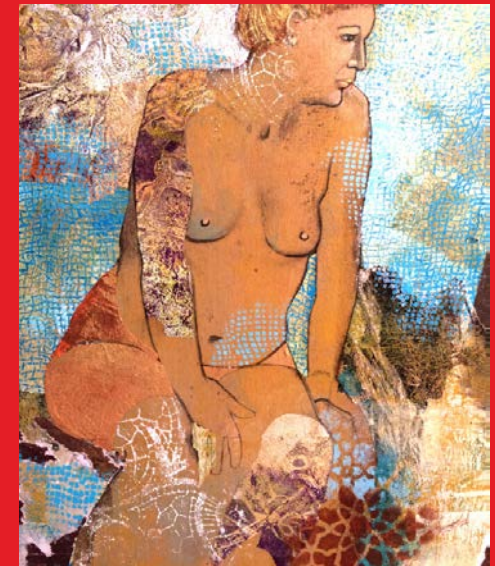

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1) Anatomical study of a lion
Bronze 6/9, £5,730, 48cm H x 68cm W x 18cm D. This bronze sculpture was designed and modelled to convey the strength and magnificence of this regal animal.



3) Scottish blackface ram
Bronze 6/9, £4,250, 60cm H x 62cm W x 42cm D. Modelled in clay and cast in bronze, this portrait of a ram with its magnificent horns wildly spiralling outwards occupying an active use of space, is lifesize and exudes a strong physical presence.



2) Perseus
Bronze 3/9, £4,230, 74cm H x 37cm W x 32cm D. Son of Zeus and Danae and founder of Mycenae, Perseus defeated Medusa and saved Andromeda with the help of Pegasus.

4) Anatomical study of the horse
Bronze 1/25, £3,760, 36cm H x 43cm W x 12cm D. Davies modelled this hunter/thoroughbred type horse in a way that exhibits the beauty of its skeletal shape, musculature and positioning of the arteries and veins. This sculpture is a study and celebration of the Anatomical mechanism of the horse.

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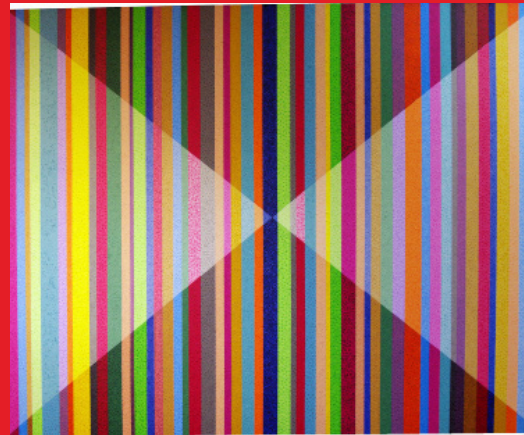
2) And In Those Fields

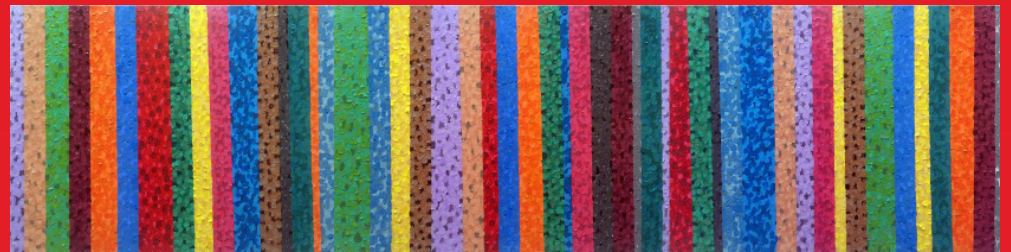


1) Barcode Geo

A development in my Barcode series, I explore geometric shapes here and enjoy creating light and shade purely through dots of paint across multiple layers and shades. There are NO lines or background colours painted. 30,000+ dots of paint. 150 shades of colour. 17 Days. Signed, named and dated on the reverse.

With no painted lines but only thousands of layered and carefully placed brushstrokes or dots on the canvases, this group of three canvases is sold as one triptych work. 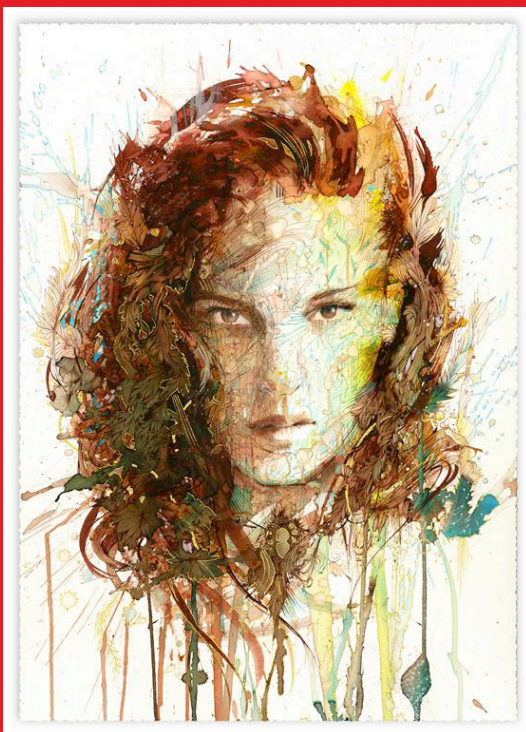
4) Moon Rise

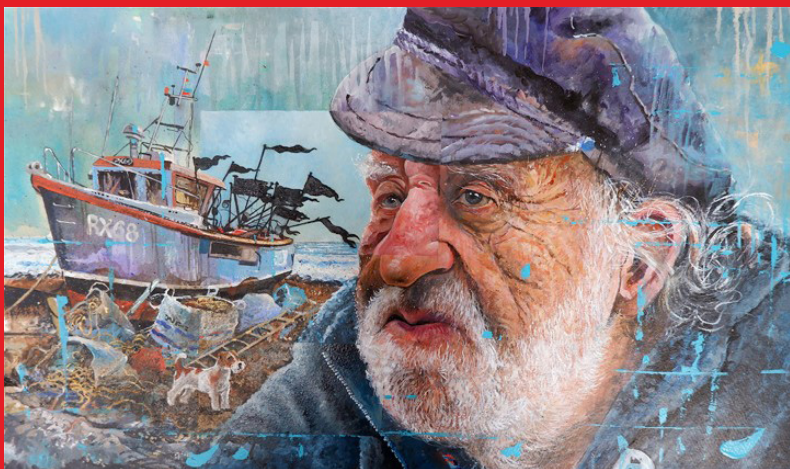

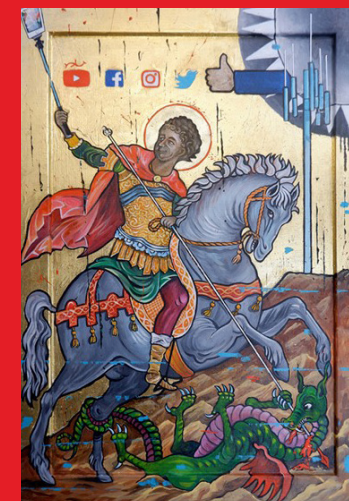

 Stoneware and applied underglazes, £450, 42cm x 18cm x 10cm. Tigers are one of the most widely recognisable animals in the world and unfortunately are also facing the threat of extinction. With this sculpture I want to capture the grace of this beautiful species in motion.

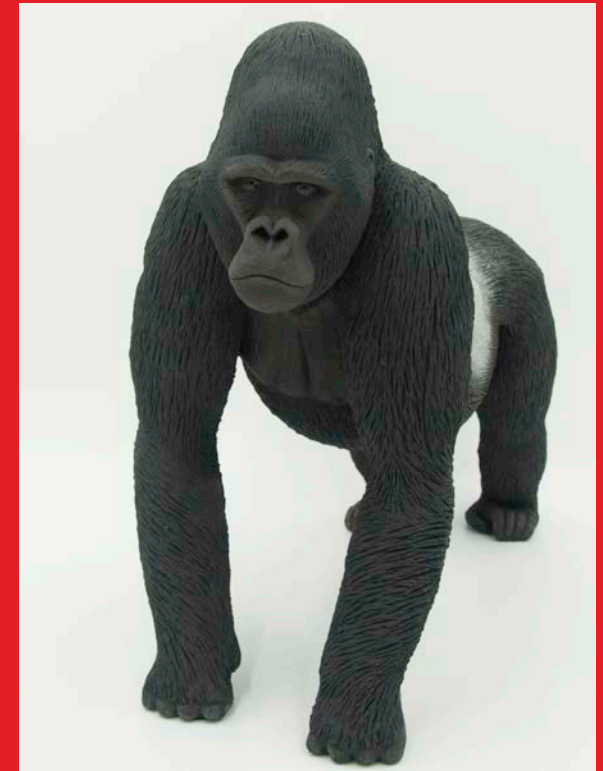


1) "Love is in the air" King penguin (*Aptenodytes patagonicus*)
 Stoneware and applied underglazes, £900 pair, 47cm x 15cm x 13cm (each individual). Each year king penguins engage in highly ritualised courtship behaviours that strengthen the bonds between the breeding pair. The sculpture aims to capture the beauty of this intriguing behaviour.



4) "Malayan Tapir" (*Tapirus indicus*)
 Stoneware and applied underglazes, £550. Malayan tapirs are a strange but beautiful species. This sculpture was based on observations at several UK zoological gardens where I repeatedly observed these animals sitting and relaxing the day away.

3) "Chief" Mountain Gorilla (*Gorilla beringei beringei*)
 Stoneware and applied underglazes, £500, 37cm x 32cm x 17cm. I have been fascinated by Mountain gorillas since my childhood and with this sculpture I wanted to capture the power of the silverback as he stands and surveys his domain.

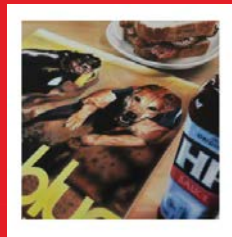

1) Blur - Parklife

Released in 1994, the album cover photo showing two greyhounds was taken at Walthamstow Greyhound track. The theme running through the 'Parklife' album is a celebration of British 'caff' culture, so a doorstep bacon sandwich and the quintessential bottle of HP brown sauce created fitting accompaniments.



Matt Sparrow is a self taught artist, who focuses on photorealism. Originally concentrating on portraiture, his most recent works have moved towards still life, with his inspiration coming from his love of music and British culture and the inextricable link between the two. All prints are Giclee on Museum heavy quality paper. All Music Prints 3 available sizes 800 x 800, 650 x 650, 500 x 500 (millimetres) £200, £150 and £100 respectively (signed and numbered 200) Storm in a Teacup 300 x 750 mm £120.



2) Oasis - Definitely Maybe

With the intense rivalry between the two bands, Oasis were the obvious follow-up to Blur. The album cover itself is hugely interesting, with a photo of the iconic George Best in the background highlighting the band's Manchester roots. Matt chose a bottle of Blue Moon Craft Beer which alludes to the anthem which Manchester City football team walk onto the pitch to. The packet of Benson and Hedges can be spotted on the album cover (see if you can spot it!) and again as part of the still life subject matter, the packaging is contemporary with the album release in 1994.

3) De La Soul - 3 feet high and rising
 Matt selected this album as it includes a sample from one of his favourite songs, 'Peg' by Steely Dan and because of the fantastically vibrant album cover which was a lot of fun to paint. Just before the track '3 is the magic number', the fictional game show host asks the question 'how many fibres are intertwined in a Shredded Wheat biscuit'. Ludens cough sweets are referenced at least 4 times in the album, which sees the 30th anniversary of it's release in 2019 with De La Soul touring the album to commemorate the occasion.



4) 'Storm in a teacup'

A derivation of the album series, this painting again includes archetypal British subject matter, classic Heinz tomato ketchup, alongside two perfectly poached eggs. The painting shows humour with the Stormtrooper in the foreground searching for the missing 'Finn' from 'The Force Awakens' peeping out from behind the ketchup bottle.

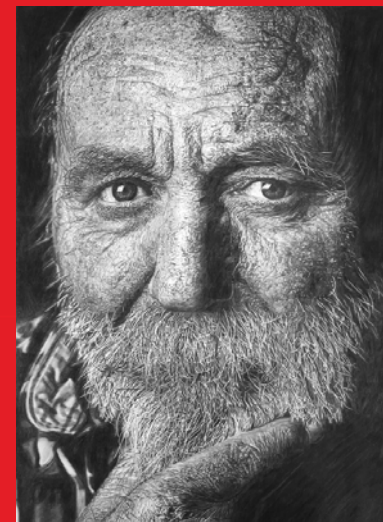
1) Leopard (Part of the "Into The Wild" collection)

All though it was a challenge using colour at first because it's not just one colour fits all for example the banana consisted of 13 colours, 6 different shades of yellow to get the right colour, I did enjoy every bit of creating this piece and I hope you enjoy it too.

The inspirational and insightful book entitled "The Alchemist" by Paulo Coelho was the inspiration behind this drawing I called the Alchemist and my depiction of a weathered, bearded man gazing fixedly towards the viewer. This was one of my larger more detailed portraits pushing the subject to the foreground and inviting the viewer to observe the microscopic details that comprises this piece such as the deep crevices of wrinkles and clusters of sunspots, stray hairs, and various imbedded skin textures.

It took hundreds of hours to create and standing back from my finished work always reveals a wonderful sight.

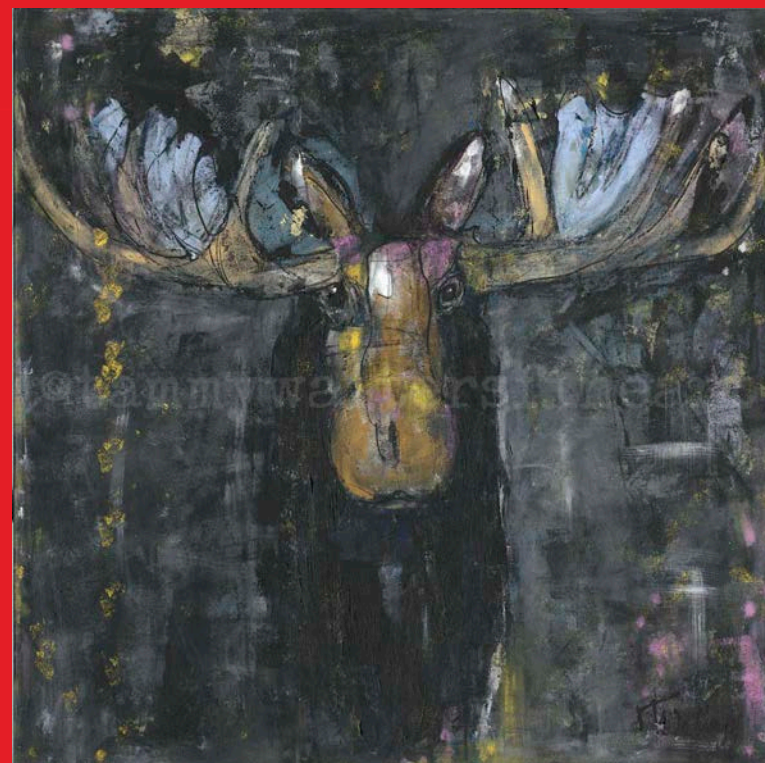
